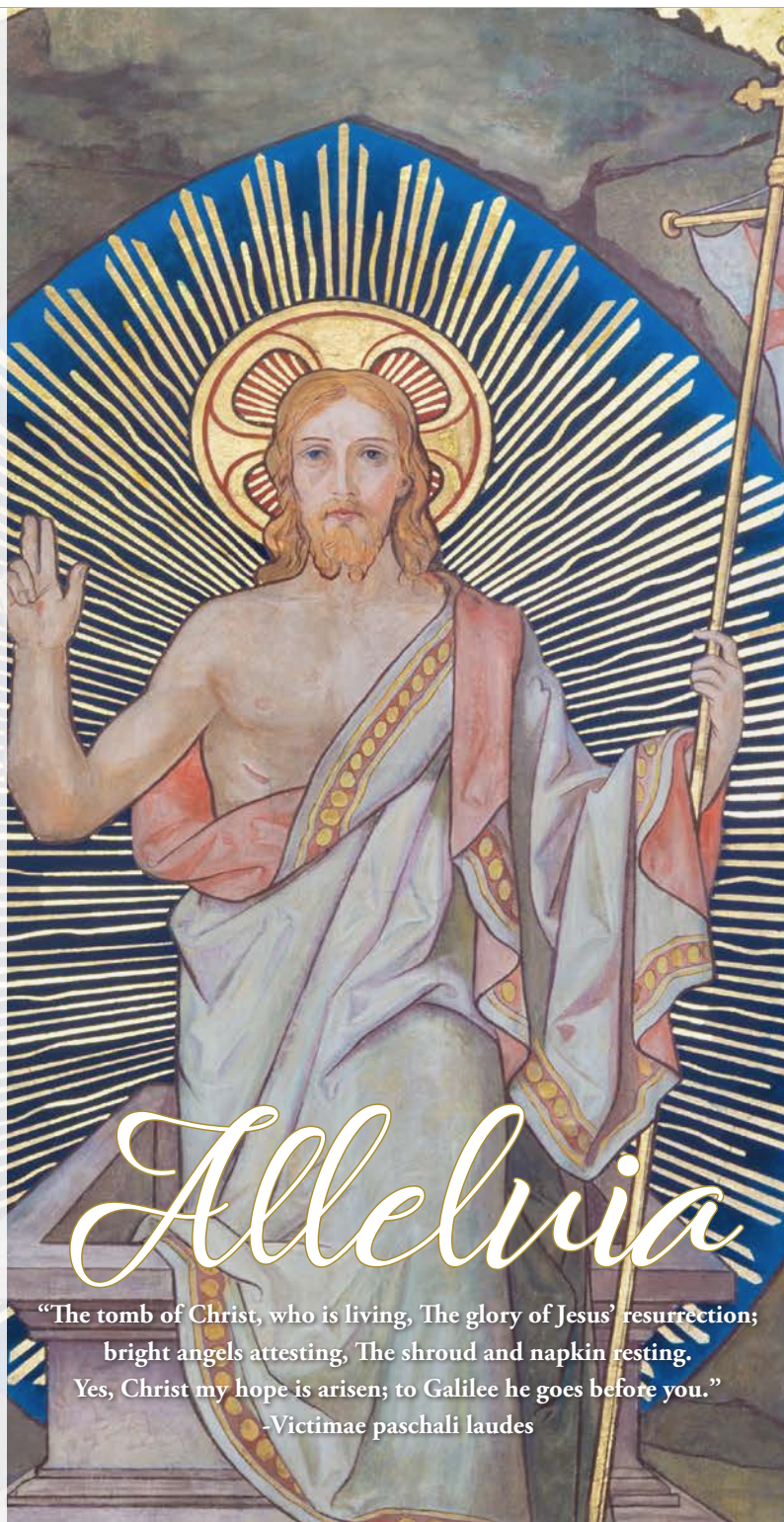

FROM THE PRIEST

I always appreciate my friendships in my life (to the point where my parents say I love my friends more than my family)! And I think Jesus spells out what friendship means – to have the same trust and love for each other; literally to give ourselves totally to each other.

How can this kind of friendship exist? Well, God made us in love for love. God is love and He does everything because of His love for us! He loves us so much that He's willing to do anything for us, including sending His only Son to suffer and die as a sacrifice for all of our sins, so we may have everlasting life as His adopted sons and daughters in Jesus Christ!

Jesus gave His disciples a new commandment which was a new way of loving and serving one another – His love was pointed at the good of others. He loves them for who they are, which is why He laid down His life for all of us so that nothing can separate us from God! And we must do the same – to love God and to serve others!

Jesus called His disciples His friends and did everything with them – He even shared His thoughts with them! To know Jesus is to know God's love and His friendship which He offers to all of us!

But God's love is more than just being obedient – this love has no reservations and is sacrificial – it is a love to the death; a love that is selfless and self-giving that puts others before ourselves. Jesus showed His love for all of us by giving His life on the cross at Calvary. Not only are our sins “washed away” but we have new life through the Holy Spirit.

May we imitate our Lord and recognize the crosses in our lives and when these crosses intersect with God's will, may we always do God's will filled with God's love knowing we have a friend in Jesus Christ!

The Appeal gives us the opportunity to support the good works and ministries that bring hope to many of our brothers and sisters throughout the 23 counties of our Diocese, especially in our parish community! There are two things I ask from you – prayers that we may remember God's love in everything we do and to try to participate – whether it's a penny or whatever amount, it will help immensely.
- The month of May is dedicated to The Blessed Virgin Mary; may we never forget the Resurrection of her Son she was worthy to bear! We will have May Crownings at all the Masses and if you would like to bring flowers to the Mary statue on display, you may do so.
- A reminder that next weekend is Mother's Day; we will have a special blessing and flowers to give to mothers after all the Masses.

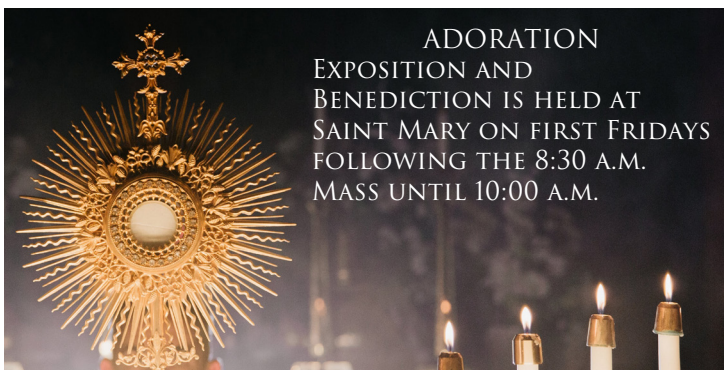
