## FROM THE PRIEST

One of my biggest fears is missing out on what's most important in life. The Gospel alludes to this fear about ten single ladies getting ready for a wedding procession...

Many of you know weddings take time, especially with many customs! And wedding customs in ancient Palestine took time to get ready for anyone involved in these customs.

One such custom is with the bride and groom celebrating – they did not go somewhere far away for their honeymoon, but instead they celebrated for a whole week with family and friends! And it was customary for the groom with his friends to come (whenever he wanted to) pick up his bride and bring her to their new home.

They would take the longest route so the procession (and party) would be bigger, but once they got to the new couple's home, the door would be shut, and no one else would be invited! And, if they came during the night, they would need lights to guide the procession through the streets to get to the home – it was illegal to travel through the streets without a light!

Like the maidens who were unprepared for the procession, Jesus warns us that there are consequences for being unprepared, especially in regards to our faith! We cannot automatically think we are getting to Heaven; we have our entire lives to work on our faith to hear Jesus' call and we need to follow, not later on, but today!

Jesus invites us to feast at the heavenly table, but are we ready to wine and dine?!?

- Pray for Pope Francis, Bishop Fernandes and for an increase of vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life!
- Pray for those affected by natural disasters and acts of violence (Ukraine; Israel & Palestine; Cameroon; floods in Somalia; storm Ciaran; fires in California)
- Pray for the repose of the souls of Don Alexander, James Sauer, Judith Alfred and William Paszke who passed away. May they rest in peace.
- The Music at St. Mary Concert Series continues this weekend; details are in the bulletin.
- This past Saturday was Veterans Day; we thank God for those who served in the military to protect our freedom. There will be a blessing at all the Masses.

*Al igual que las doncellas que no estaban preparadas para la procesión, Jesús nos advierte que hay consecuencias por no estar preparados, ¡especialmente en lo que respecta a nuestra fe! No podemos pensar automáticamente que estamos llegando al Cielo; Tenemos toda nuestra vida para trabajar en nuestra fe para escuchar el llamado de Jesús y debemos seguirlo, no más adelante, ¡sino hoy!*

*Jesús nos invita a deleitarnos en la mesa celestial, pero ¿¿estamos listos para tomar vino y cenar!!?*

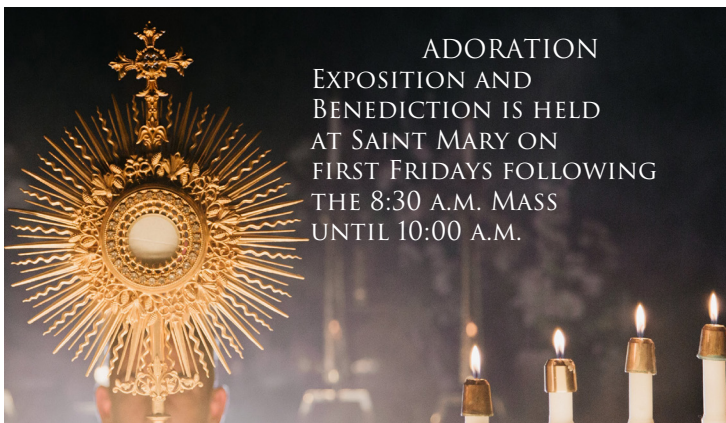
