FROM THE PRIEST

This weekend is the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, who is the King of the Universe! We hear about the sheep and the goats in this weekend's Gospel, but what do sheep and goats have to do with God's Judgement Day?

In dry lands (like Palestine), goats and sheep ate together during the day because there were not many "green" fields around! And when evening began, the shepherd would bring the sheep and the goats back to rest, and separate them into two groups.

Goats, as we know, tend to be pushy and territorial and they butt heads with their horns whenever someone's "in their space". And in those times, goats were a "symbol" of evil, even creating the expression "scapegoat" for someone to have the blame for others!

We have a choice – we can follow Jesus as our Savior or be our own master and go our own way instead of God's way. We cannot remain neutral to the commands of Christ. If we do not recognize our wrongdoing and obey the Gospel, we cannot be authentic disciples or receive His kingdom! And it can lead to sin and separation!

When Jesus comes again as judge and ruler over all, He will call each one of us to stand before His seat of judgement and ask whom did we love and put first in life? If we put our faith in Jesus Christ and follow His way of love and righteousness, we will have life and peace with God in His kingdom. And if we let His Holy Spirit clean our hearts and minds, then Jesus will give us the graces to live each day in His merciful love and compassion for all!

May we always entrust our lives to Jesus and let His Holy Spirit clean our hearts and minds, so we may live each day in the power of His love and goodness! And may His love rule in our hearts so we may think and act with charity for all!

DEL SACERDOTE

¡Este fin de semana es la Solemnidad de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, quien es el Rey del Universo! Escuchamos acerca de las ovejas y las cabras en el evangelio de este fin de semana, pero ¿qué tienen que ver las ovejas y las cabras con el Día del Juicio de Dios?

En las tierras secas (como Palestina), las cabras y las ovejas comían juntas durante el día porque no había muchos campos "verdes" alrededor. Y cuando llegaba la tarde, el pastor hacía descansar a las ovejas y a las cabras y las separaba en dos grupos.

Las cabras, como sabemos, tienden a ser agresivas y territoriales y se golpean la cabeza con los cuernos cada vez que alguien está "en su espacio". Y en aquellos tiempos, las cabras eran un "símbolo" del mal, llegando incluso a crearse la expresión "chivo expiatorio" para que alguien tuviera la culpa de los demás.

Tenemos una opción: podemos seguir a Jesús como nuestro Salvador o ser nuestro propio maestro y seguir nuestro propio camino en lugar del camino de Dios. No podemos permanecer neutrales a los mandamientos de Cristo; si no reconocemos nuestras malas acciones y obedecemos el Evangelio, ¿no podemos ser discípulos auténticos ni recibir Su reino! ¡Y puede conducir al pecado y a la separación!

Cuando Jesús regrese nuevamente como juez y gobernante sobre todo, nos llamará a cada uno de nosotros a presentarnos ante Su tribunal y preguntarnos ¿a quién amamos y pusimos primero en la vida? Si ponemos nuestra fe en Jesucristo y seguimos Su camino de amor y justicia, tendremos vida y paz con Dios en Su reino. ¡Y si permitimos que Su Espíritu Santo limpie nuestros corazones y mentes, entonces Jesús nos dará las gracias para vivir cada día en Su amor misericordioso y compasión por todos!

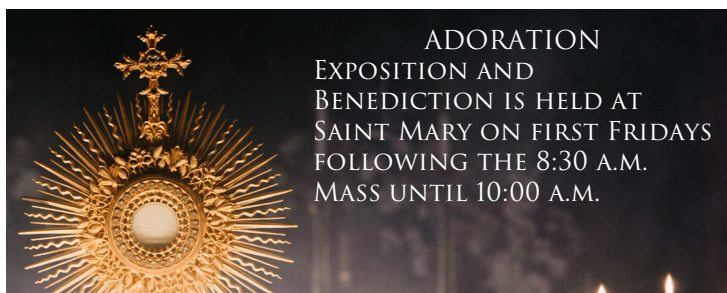

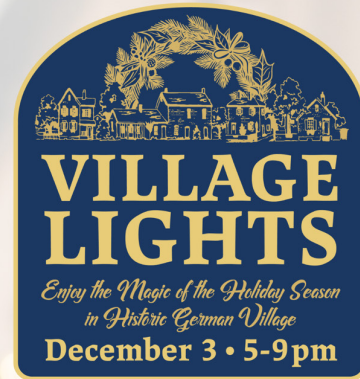
WOMEN'S MINISTRY ADVENT BOOK STUDY

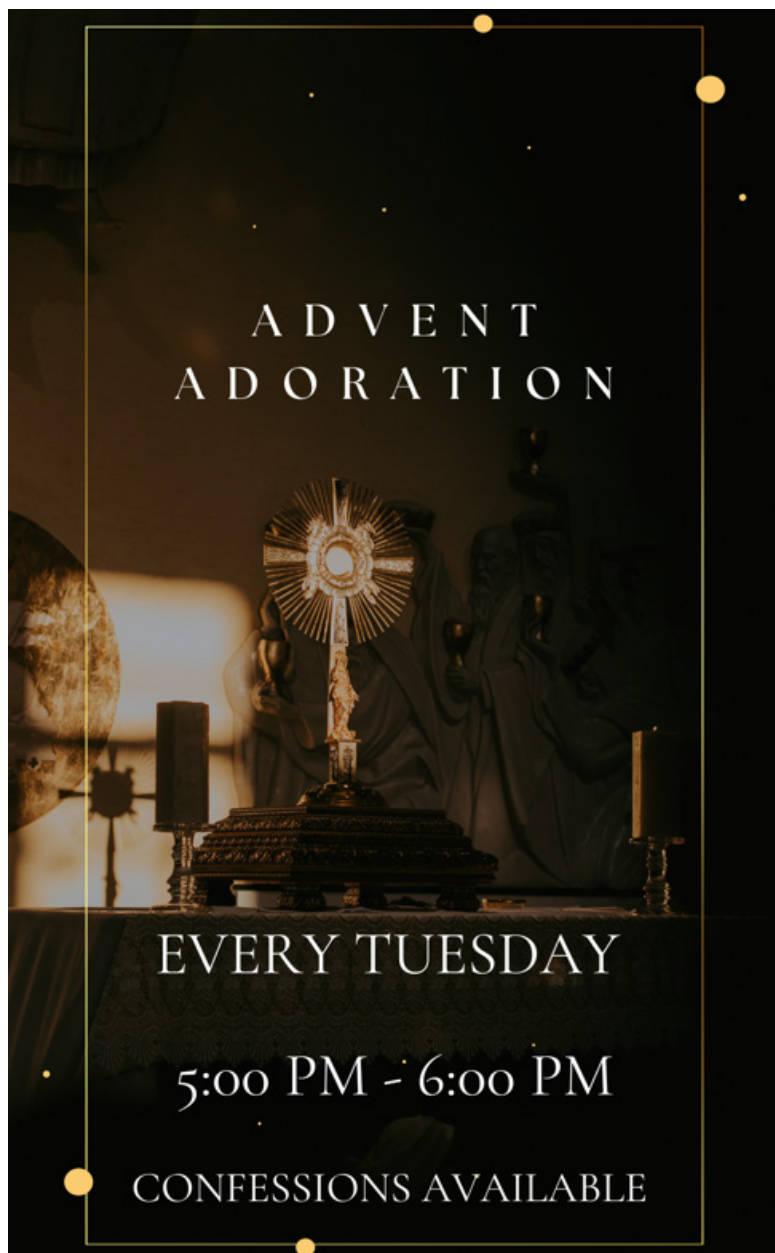
