FROM THE PRIEST

She's been waiting for him for a long time.

My best friend's wife has been waiting for him to come home since he was deployed to Afghanistan. And I promised my best friend I would be there for her, but it's not the same as my best friend being there. He's been away for 2 years and they were finally reunited!

I wonder how she felt during those two long years of my friend being gone, but promised to return home soon...anticipating his return back home but never knowing when that was going to happen...

Jesus' parable about the long expected return of the Master really brings this out!

Landowners left their estates in the hands of their servants and stewards whom they trusted so they could focus on other endeavors (travel, trade or business). They expected loyalty and hard work from their servants and stewards, and they would be rewarded by their master for keeping the estate in good shape! And some servants and stewards could not wait for their master to return to see how great they kept the estate up to par!

Like any big reunion or event, we often wait with excitement and anticipation, and Jesus expects us to be excited and prepared about the most important event of all – His return in glory at the end of this age! This is why we celebrate the Advent season which begins this weekend – it reminds us that we are living in the end times, which start with the First Coming of Christ (John 1:14) and end in Christ's Second Coming! We know that Jesus will come again, but we do not know when it will happen. When He comes, it will be at a time and date we do not know, and we must not be caught off guard when He comes to judge the living and the dead!

Even though we do not know when Christ will come again, He wants us to use this time now to use our God-given talents, abilities and graces to help, serve, bless, and love others as well for His glory! Advent is a time to remind ourselves that the Lord is coming! As Jesus' servants, we need to continually seek Him and be watchful for His Second Coming!

May we keep our hearts and minds open to receive His word; prepare for His coming again; and free us from complacency and anything that will keep us away from Him!

Me pregunto cómo se sintió durante esos dos largos años en los que mi amigo se fue, pero prometió regresar a casa pronto... anticipando su regreso a casa pero sin saber cuándo iba a suceder...

¡La parábola de Jesús sobre el tan esperado regreso del Maestro realmente pone esto de manifiesto!

Los terratenientes dejaban sus propiedades en manos de sus sirvientes y mayordomos en quienes confiaban para poder dedicarse a otras actividades (viajes, comercio o negocios). Esperaban lealtad y trabajo duro de sus sirvientes y mayordomos, ¡y su amo los recompensaría manteniendo la propiedad en buenas condiciones! ¡Y algunos sirvientes y mayordomos no podían esperar a que su amo regresara para ver cuán bien mantenían la propiedad a la altura!

Como cualquier gran reunión o evento, a menudo esperamos con entusiasmo y anticipación, y Jesús espera que estemos emocionados y preparados para el evento más importante de todos: ¡Su regreso en gloria al final de esta era! Es por eso que celebramos la temporada de Adviento que comienza este fin de semana: nos recuerda que estamos viviendo en los últimos tiempos, que comienzan con la primera venida de Cristo (Juan 1:14) y terminan en la segunda venida de Cristo. Sabemos que Jesús vendrá otra vez, pero no sabemos cuándo sucederá. Cuando Él venga, será en una fecha y hora que no sabemos, ¡y no debemos ser tomados por sorpresa cuando Él venga a juzgar a los vivos y a los muertos!

Aunque no sabemos cuándo volverá Cristo, Él quiere que usemos este tiempo ahora para usar los talentos, habilidades y gracias que Dios nos ha dado para ayudar, servir, bendecir y amar a otros también para Su gloria. ¡El Adviento es un tiempo para recordarnos que el Señor viene! Como siervos de Jesús, debemos buscarlo continuamente y estar atentos a su segunda venida.

Que mantengamos nuestro corazón y nuestra mente abiertos para recibir Su palabra; prepárense para su venida nuevamente; ¡Y libéranos de la complacencia y de todo lo que nos aleje de Él!






