FROM THE PRIEST

What do you seek?

Who is Jesus for you?

These questions are main questions I hear all the time as a priest, and we hear them in the Gospel today.

John was the son of Zachariah, the high priest. As priest, Zachariah had a daily sacrifice of a lamb in the temple for the sins of the people. That's key because John recognizes Jesus as the "true sacrifice" who could deliver us from sin, death and the devil.

But how did John recognize Jesus as the "true sacrifice"? The Holy Spirit showed John who Jesus really is as the Son of God! And we receive the same Holy Spirit through our faith!

The Holy Spirit makes Jesus Christ known to us through that special gift of faith, and God gives His Spirit to us so that we can understand (with the eyes of faith) God's plan to unite everything under Jesus Christ!

With humility, John was able to point to Jesus Christ instead of himself, and pointed his disciples to Him! And when two of John's disciples came to seek Jesus, Jesus met them halfway and asked "What are you looking for?"

Jesus asks all of us the same question – what are you looking for and what is your purpose for your life? Only God can answer that question and we can then understand our true purpose – that's why Jesus invites all of us to Himself – He wants us to know Him personally! Jesus invites all of us to "come and see" the joy of friendship and communion with God for love! God is the one who starts the relationship and draws us to Him; without His mercy and help, we cannot find Him on our own!

And when we find something awesome, don't we like to share it with others? Well, Andrew does the same; once Andrew met Jesus, he recognized that He was really the Messiah and went to tell his brother Simon the good news! When Jesus saw Simon coming, He immediately reached out to Simon, just like what He had done for Andrew beforehand, and revealed to Simon that He knew who Simon was even before Simon came!

Jesus gave Simon a new name – Cephas, which is the Aramaic word for "rock," which was one of the greatest compliments back in the ancient day! Because of faith, Peter understood who Jesus was – the Messiah and the only Son of God! The Holy Spirit gives us the gift of faith to know Jesus personally, to live the Gospel out and the courage to be a real witness of the Gospel to others!

May the Holy Spirit be on fire in our hearts that we may seek to do His will in all things!

DEL SACERDOTE

¿Qué buscas?

¿Quién es Jesús para ti?

Estas son preguntas principales que escucho todo el tiempo como sacerdote, y las escuchamos hoy en el evangelio.

Juan era hijo de Zacarías, el sumo sacerdote. Como sacerdote, Zacarías tenía un sacrificio diario de un cordero en el templo por los pecados del pueblo. Esa es la clave porque Juan reconoce a Jesús como el "verdadero sacrificio" que podría librarnos del pecado, la muerte y el diablo.

Pero ¿cómo reconoció Juan a Jesús como el "verdadero sacrificio"? ¡El Espíritu Santo le mostró a Juan quién es realmente Jesús como el Hijo de Dios! ¡Y recibimos el mismo Espíritu Santo a través de nuestra fe!

¡El Espíritu Santo nos da a conocer a Jesucristo a través de ese regalo especial de la fe y Dios nos da Su Espíritu para que podamos entender (con los ojos de la fe) el plan de Dios de unir todo bajo Jesucristo!

Con humildad, Juan pudo señalar a Jesucristo en lugar de a sí mismo, y señaló a sus discípulos hacia Él! Y cuando dos de los discípulos de Juan vinieron a buscar a Jesús, Jesús los encontró a medio camino y les preguntó: "¿Qué buscáis?"

Jesús nos hace a todos la misma pregunta: ¿qué estás buscando y cuál es el propósito de tu vida? Sólo Dios puede responder esa pregunta y podemos entender nuestro verdadero propósito; es por eso que Jesús nos invita a todos a sí mismo. ¡Quiere que lo conozcamos personalmente! ¡Jesús nos invita a todos a "venir y ver" la alegría de la amistad y la comunión con Dios por amor! Dios es quien inicia la relación y nos atrae hacia Él; ¡Sin Su misericordia y ayuda, no podemos encontrarlo por nuestra cuenta!

Y cuando encontramos algo asombroso, ¿no nos gusta compartirlo con los demás? Bueno, Andrew hace lo mismo; Una vez que Andrés conoció a Jesús, reconoció que Él era realmente el Mesías y fue a contarle la buena noticia a su hermano Simón. Cuando Jesús vio venir a Simón, inmediatamente se acercó a Simón, tal como lo había hecho antes con Simón, y le reveló que sabía quién era Simón incluso antes de que viniera!

Jesús le dio a Simón un nuevo nombre: Cefas, que es la palabra aramea para "roca", ¡lo cual fue uno de los mayores cumplidos en la antigüedad! Gracias a la fe, Pedro entendió quién era Jesús: ¡el Mesías y el único Hijo de Dios! ¡El Espíritu Santo nos da el don de la fe para conocer a Jesús personalmente, para vivir el evangelio y el valor para ser un verdadero testigo del evangelio para los demás!

¡Que el Espíritu Santo arda en nuestros corazones para que busquemos hacer Su voluntad en todas las cosas!

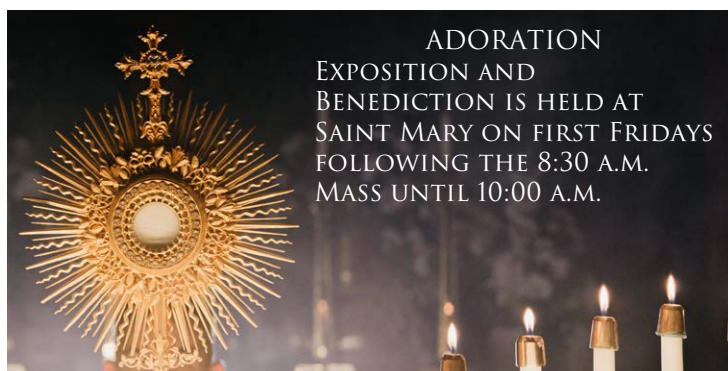

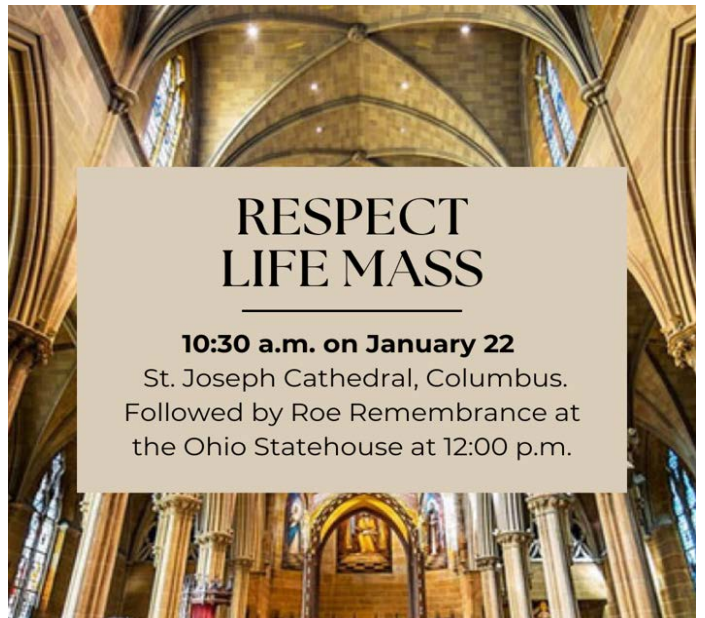

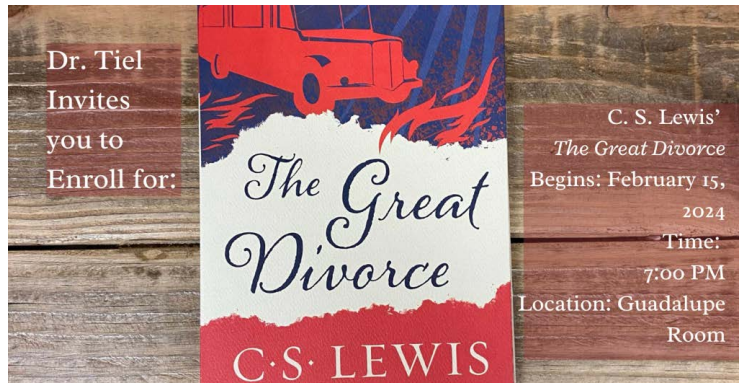
