## FROM THE PRIEST

I had never seen leprosy until I was an ordained priest visiting the hospital to anoint a person...

It was in an advanced stage, but when I came to anoint the person, her crucifix and her rosary were right by her side and she told me that her faith is strong and that “not even leprosy can get me down!” The Gospel this weekend reminds me of that person... during Jesus’ time, lepers were outcasts of society and were “kicked out” of local communities, left to take care of themselves, and their own families thought they were already dead...

The Jewish law forbade anyone from being with the person with leprosy, because that would be ritual defilement!

But the leper in today’s Gospel did something that was amazing – he approached Jesus with full confidence that He would heal him. Most of the time, lepers would be stoned or pushed away if they came close to a rabbi, but Jesus heals this man and shows God’s love by touching the leper!

By Jesus’ touch, Jesus didn’t have to say a word, because He showed God’s love by healing him spiritually and physically as well!

I think the Gospel is asking us today, how do we deal with people who are rejected by others because of a physical deformity, a disease or someone difficult to love? Do we show them assistance and mercy like Christ always did?

May we continue to ask Jesus to place in our hearts His love and make us clean spiritually and physically so we never doubt His love and help others compassionately!

- Pray for those who lead the Church, especially Pope Francis and Bishop Fernandes.
- Pray for those affected by natural disasters and acts of violence (Israel/Palestine; Middle East); Ukraine; wildfires in Chile; storms in Southern California).
- This Sunday is World Marriage Day where we celebrate the vocation of marriage! May all couples continue to be blessed and united as one!
- This Sunday is also World Day of the Sick, an observation introduced by Pope John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses. We will have Anointing of the Sick available after all the Masses.
- Just a reminder that Wednesday, February 14 begins Lent with Ash Wednesday (which means no meat on Valentine’s Day!) The schedule is: 8:30 a.m. Mass (School Mass), 12:00 p.m. Service (No Liturgy of the Eucharist), 5:00 p.m. Mass (Spanish), 6:30 p.m. Mass
  - There will be Confessions heard 45 minutes before the 6:30 p.m. Mass.
- Starting February 20 at 5:15 p.m., we will have Adoration/Benediction with the Sacrament of Penance available every Tuesday during Lent. It will conclude at 6:15 p.m. with Benediction, followed by 6:30 p.m. Mass. Spend time with the Lord this Lent!
- Stations of the Cross begin February 16, 7:00 p.m. and will happen every Friday during Lent.
- We are participating in the 40 Days of Adoration with the diocese where different parishes throughout the diocese are having Adoration, Benediction and Confessions. Our date is March 5 from 8:30 a.m. to 6:15 p.m. We will have sign-up sheets soon.

## DEL SACERDOTE

*Nunca había visto lepra hasta que fui ordenado sacerdote visitando el hospital para ungir a una persona...*

*Estaba en una etapa avanzada, pero cuando llegué a ungir a la persona, su crucifijo y su rosario estaban a su lado y me dijeron que su fe es fuerte y que “¡ni la lepra puede derribarme!”*

*El evangelio de este fin de semana recuerda a esa persona... durante el tiempo de Jesús, los leprosos eran marginados de la sociedad y eran “expulsados” de las comunidades locales, abandonados a cuidar de sí mismos, y sus propias familias pensaban que ya estaban muertos...*

*La ley judía prohibía a cualquiera estar con la persona leprosa, ¡porque eso sería una contaminación ritual!*

*Pero el leproso del evangelio de hoy hizo algo sorprendente: se acercó a Jesús con plena confianza de que Él lo sanaría. La mayoría de las veces, los leprosos serían apedreados o empujados si se acercaban a un rabino, ¡pero Jesús sana a este hombre y muestra el amor de Dios al tocar al leproso!*

*¡Por el toque de Jesús, Jesús no tuvo que decir una palabra, porque mostró el amor de Dios al sanarlo espiritual y físicamente también!*

*Creo que el evangelio nos pregunta hoy, ¿cómo tratamos a las personas que son rechazadas por otros por una deformidad física, una enfermedad o alguien difícil de amar? ¿Les mostramos asistencia y misericordia como siempre lo hizo Cristo?*

*¡Que sigamos pidiéndole a Jesús que ponga en nuestros corazones Su amor y nos limpie espiritual y físicamente para que nunca dudemos de Su amor y ayudemos a los demás con compasión!*

- *Oren por quienes dirigen la Iglesia, especialmente el Papa Francisco y el obispo Fernandes.*
- *Oren por los afectados por desastres naturales y actos de violencia (Israel/Palestina; Medio Oriente); Ucrania; incendios forestales en Chile; tormenta en el sur de California)*
- *¡Este domingo es el Día Mundial del Matrimonio donde celebramos la vocación del matrimonio! ¡Que todas las parejas sigan siendo bendecidas unidas como una sola!*
- *Este domingo también es el Día Mundial del Enfermo, una celebración introducida por el Papa Juan Pablo II como una forma para que los creyentes ofrezcan oraciones por quienes padecen enfermedades. Tendremos la Unción de los Enfermos disponible después de todas las Misas.*
- *¡Solo un recordatorio de que el miércoles 14 de febrero comienza la Cuaresma con el Miércoles de Ceniza (lo que significa que no habrá carne en el Día de San Valentín)! El horario es: 8:30 a.m. Misa (Misa Escolar), Servicio de 12:00 p.m. (No hay Liturgia de la Eucaristía), 5:00 p.m. Misa (español), 6:30 p.m. Misa*
  - *Se escucharán confesiones 45 minutos antes de la misa de las 6:30 p.m.*
