FROM THE PRIEST

Covenants.

We hear about covenants in today's First Reading and in the Gospel this weekend.

Covenants are important since they are a bond of peace and friendship that draws men and women to God! We see covenants throughout the Bible – God established them with His people when He freed them from Egypt and brought them to Mount Sinai, but His people continued to break those covenants and did not follow His ways (Exodus 6:7). Even though that happened, God continued to send prophets to draw His people back!!!

In the First Reading, we hear that Jeremiah was sent to the exiles to offer them a message of a new covenant that would be better than the other covenant that God made. God wanted to establish a new covenant that would wipe away all the sins of His people, and open the way to God's mercy and blessing!

This was a foreshadowing of Jesus, who would be the ultimate sacrifice that Jesus would offer to God the Father, sealing the new covenant. Jesus, the Son of God, was sent from God the Father in Heaven to become man so He could, as a man, offer the true sacrifice that would unite us with God and give us life everlasting!

In the Gospel today, just before Passover was to start, Jesus told His disciples that the "hour has come for the Son of man to be glorified" (John 12:23). The Jewish people of Jesus' time were looking for a Messiah that would free them from Rome's rule, but Jesus came to set people free from far worse slavery – slavery to sin and death and to the devil!

Jesus came to bring us into a new covenant with God so our lives do not end at death, but leads us into eternal life!

Jesus knew that He would be "lifted up" and "draw all people to Himself" (John 12:32) by His suffering and death on the cross! He freely went through this to fulfill His Father's will and finish the mission that was given by God! He overcame the devil and took our sins on Himself and nailed them on the cross to set us free from death, so we can have a real relationship with God! Its hard to see that suffering and death on the cross can bring new life, but Jesus uses an illustration of a grain of wheat! Seeds by themselves are worth nothing. Only when the seed is destroyed by putting it in the ground, it can rise to new life and bear fruit! Jesus' cross frees us from sin and death, and shows us the way of perfect love and eagerness to lay down our lives in service for others!

To receive new life and the fruit of the Spirit that Jesus offers us, our "old fallen self" of sin must die (in Baptism); once that happens, we receive God's forgiveness and the power of the Holy Spirit to love and serve others and to follow God!

May we bear much fruit for Our Lord by denying ourselves and embrace His will for our lives, following Him wherever He leads us!

DEL SACERDOTE

Pactos.

Escuchamos acerca de los pactos en la Primera Lectura de hoy y en el evangelio de este fin de semana.

¡Los pactos son importantes ya que son un vínculo de paz y amistad que atrae a hombres y mujeres hacia Dios! Vemos pactos en toda la Biblia: Dios estableció con Su pueblo cuando los liberó de Egipto y los llevó al Monte Sinaí, pero Su pueblo continuó rompiendo esos pactos y no siguió Sus caminos (Éxodo 6:7). ¡¡¡Aunque eso sucedió, Dios continuó enviando profetas para hacer regresar a Su pueblo!!!

En la Primera Lectura escuchamos que Jeremías fue enviado a los exiliados para ofrecerles un mensaje de una nueva alianza que sería mejor que la otra alianza que Dios hizo. ¡Dios quería establecer un nuevo pacto que borraría todos los pecados de su pueblo y abriría el camino a la misericordia y la bendición de Dios! Esto fue un presagio de Jesús, quien sería el sacrificio supremo que Jesús ofrecería a Dios Padre, sellando el nuevo pacto. Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, fue enviado por Dios Padre en el Cielo para hacerse hombre y poder, como hombre, ofrecer el verdadero sacrificio que nos uniría con Dios y nos daría vida eterna.

En el evangelio de hoy, justo antes de que comenzara la Pascua, Jesús les dijo a sus discípulos que "ha llegado la hora de que el Hijo del Hombre sea glorificado" (Juan 12:23). El pueblo judío de la época de Jesús buscaba un Mesías que los liberara del gobierno de Roma, pero Jesús vino para liberar a la gente de una esclavitud mucho peor: ¡la esclavitud al pecado, la muerte y el diablo!

¡Jesús vino para traernos a un nuevo pacto con Dios para que nuestras vidas no terminen en la muerte, sino que nos lleven a la vida eterna!

¡Jesús sabía que sería "levantado" y "atraerá a todos hacia sí" (Juan 12:32) por Su sufrimiento y muerte en la cruz! ¡Él pasó por esto libremente para cumplir la voluntad de Su Padre y terminar la misión que le fue encomendada por Dios! Él venció al diablo, tomó nuestros pecados sobre sí mismo y los clavó en la cruz para liberarnos de la muerte, ¡para que podamos tener una relación real con Dios!

Es difícil ver que el sufrimiento y la muerte en la cruz puedan traer nueva vida, ¡pero Jesús usa una ilustración de un grano de trigo! Las semillas por sí solas no valen nada. ¡Sólo cuando la semilla es destruida al ponerla en la tierra, puede resucitar a nueva vida y dar fruto! ¡La cruz de Jesús nos libera del pecado y de la muerte y nos muestra el camino del amor perfecto y del afán de dar nuestra vida al servicio de los demás!

Para recibir vida nueva y el fruto del Espíritu que Jesús nos ofrece, nuestro "viejo yo caído" de pecado debe morir (en el Bautismo); una vez que eso sucede, recibimos el perdón de Dios y el poder del Espíritu Santo para amar y servir a los demás y seguir a Dios.

¡Que podamos dar mucho fruto para Nuestro Señor negándonos a nosotros mismos y abrazando Su voluntad para nuestras vidas, siguiéndolo a donde Él nos lleve!

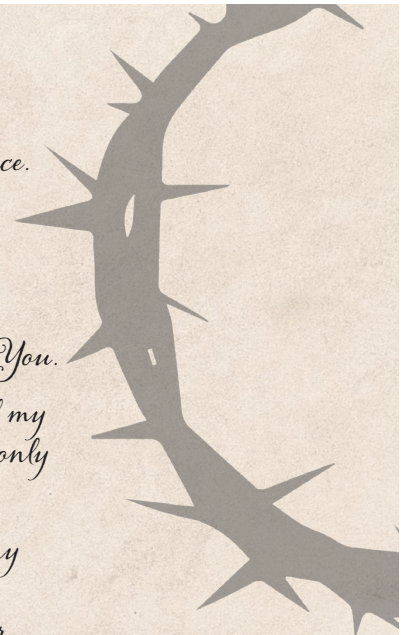
